With the exception of the meetings held by the national and international scientific societies and cooperative study groups, many congresses are currently driven by pharmaceutical companies with the main purpose to promote the use of new drugs. The main intent of this meeting, completely independent from any pharma support and sponsored by the Foundation for Clinical Research of our Hospital (FROM) and by Fondazione Internazionale Menarini, is to host key experts in the different fields of hematologic malignancies and promote an open and free discussion about the impact on clinical practice of the most recent results achieved in clinical trials. We believe that, although many hopes are coming from the development of some innovative treatments with highest therapeutic effect and lowest toxicity burden, we still do not know how these promising therapies can be applied and generalized. Similarly, we do not know whether the economic impact of these new treatments will be affordable in many countries. The topics to cover in this meeting are: acute and chronic leukemias, lymphomas, myeloma and bone marrow transplantation. In each session, 2 speakers will overview the state of the art of the single topic and argue about the impact of the results of clinical trials on the daily clinical practice of such new treatments. The chairman of each session will give an introduction to highlight the critical points of each disease. At the end of the speakers' presentation and the general discussion the chairman will summarize the conclusions and the proposals emerging from the debate.
